

A RESOLUTION

TO ISSUE A MORATORIUM ON VARIANCES FROM THE CLARKSTON SIGN ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, it has been acknowledged that the current sign ordinance does not support the long-term economic viability of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has directed staff to develop and implement a process for amending the current sign ordinance to improve its effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, a stakeholder committee consisting of citizens, business owners and sign industry professionals will be assembled to assist staff in driving the process of amending the current sign ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to continue to allow the approval of new sign permits during the sign ordinance update process, so long as they conform to the current sign ordinance as it is written and a sign variance is not requested.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Clarkston that a moratorium on the consideration of variances to the Clarkston sign ordinance be enacted for a period of 120 days, or until such time as a new or amended sign ordinance is adopted, whichever is sooner.
