

Juneteenth Celebration




The Clarkston City Council approved in December 2020 to recognize and Celebrate the 19th of June, Juneteenth. Also known as Freedom Day, Jubilee Day, and Cel-Liberation Day is an American holiday celebrated annually on June 19th. It recognizes the day, in the spring of 1865, when slaves in Galveston, Texas,---the last strong hold of slavery---learned they were free. That December, slavery in America was formally abolished with the adoption of the 13th Amendment.

Project duration is 365 calendar days.	Project construction from trailhead to Norman Rd on Row- land. Expect road closure on Roland in the summer. Work entails new granite curb on Rowland from NIC to Market, new sidewalks, traffic calming measures, trees, asphalt re- surfacing, bioswales, Clarkston Trolley Information kiosk, streetscape benches, road narrowing and pedestrian cross- ing improvements.
Expect sections of Rowland St to be closed from NIC to Market Fall 2021 for 2-3 months.	Contractor required to install SPLOST signs along the en- tire road as well as send out notifications to the property owners before work commences.
