What Does a Quality of Life Officer Do?

Our Quality of Life Officer strives to work with the public to improve the overall quality of life within the City of Clarkston.

This is accomplished primarily through issuing a warning notice of violation to property owners of residential and commercial properties informing them of infractions to the City Ordinance.

Reasonable time is allotted to correct violations in an effort to reach voluntary compliance.

Court Summons are issued by the QOL Officer only when voluntary compliance is not reached.

All court summons that are issued, requires responsible party's to appear before a municipal court judge and possibly fined.

General Scope of Work

The QOL Officer Patrols the residential and commercial areas in an effort to provide proactive enforcement through performing site inspections to determine if a violation exists and responding through appropriate actions.

In addition to proactive enforcement, the QOL Officer Patrols residential and commercial areas in response to written complaints received regarding potential violations. All written complaints are followed up with site inspections and appropriate actions.

Alcohol Review Committee

As a member of the ARC, the QOL Officer works with other members of staff to review applications for new and renewed alcohol beverage licenses.
