## City of Clarkston - City Services & Operations Adjustments, Closings, Cancellations

(Clarkston, GA)— In response to the current Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) situation, the City of Clarkston is making the following adjustments to City services & operations, including the cancellation/postponement of City public meetings, events, activities from Saturday, March 14 to April 12:

- City of Clarkston offices at City Hall (3921 Church St) and City Hall Annex (1055 Rowland St)
  beginning the week of Monday, March 16 will be CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC for an indefinite period of

  be working remotely and will respond to all inquiries within 24 hours.
