

Juneteenth Celebration




The Clarkston City Council approved in December 2020 to recognize and Celebrate the 19th of June, Juneteenth. Also known as Freedom Day, Jubilee Day, and Cel-Liberation Day is an American holiday celebrated annually on June 19th. It recognizes the day, in the spring of 1865, when slaves in Galveston, Texas,---the last strong hold of slavery---learned they were free. That December, slavery in America was formally abolished with the adoption of the 13th Amendment.

<p>Rowland Street Pedestrian Enhancements & Mell Ave Trailhead; including Rogers St from Market to North Indian Creek</p> <p>Construction Schedule: Sol Construction issued a Notice-to-Proceed 4/1/2021. Project duration is 365 calendar days.</p> <p>Expect sections of Rowland St to be closed from NIC to Market Fall 2021 for 2-3 months.</p>	<p>Project construction from trailhead to Norman Rd on Rowland. Expect road closure on Rowland in the summer. Work entails new granite curb on Rowland from NIC to Market, new sidewalks, traffic calming measures, trees, asphalt re-surfacing, bioswales, Clarkston Trolley Information kiosk, streetscape benches, road narrowing and pedestrian crossing improvements.</p> <p>Contractor required to install SPLOST signs along the entire road as well as send out notifications to the property owners before work commences.</p> <p>City council to evaluate 3 change orders at March work session for funding consideration:</p> <p>Change Order #1 – Add sidewalk north side Rogers St and drainage improvements Change Order #2 – Add sidewalk north side of Rowland from North Indian Creek to Lovejoy Change Order #3 – Methodist Church paving and striping</p> <p>If council approves additional work, CIS will meet with property owners on Rogers St and Rowland St to discuss project scope changes. improvements</p>
<p>Peachtree Creek at Ponce New Apartment</p> <p>Construction Schedule: Construction on City Right-of-Way with turn lanes at apartment complex frontage to commence in March and end in April 2021</p>	<p>Traffic delays due to developer installing new left and right turn lanes into new development</p>
<p>Debelle Street Roadway Improvements & AASD detention pond construction</p> <p>Construction Schedule: Debelle Street paving & drainage improvements completed. Detention pond on AASD property to be completed in April 2021.</p>	<p>Debelle Rd opened to traffic February 12th. Work includes traffic calming speed humps.</p>

<p>Market St sidewalks from City Annex driveway to county line</p> <p>Design Schedule: Schematic sidewalk layouts (2 alternatives) to be presented to council in June 2020</p>	<p>Survey and utility locate work to support new SPLOST sidewalk project on-going</p>
<p>Streetscape Project</p> <p>Construction Schedule: Streetscape project completion end of March 2021</p>	<p>Project is 99% complete. Remaining work includes landscape installation (trees) bus shelters panels, mailboxes, final striping and punch list repairs</p>
<p>Rivers Alive Event</p> <p>Schedule: March 27th, 2021; 9 am</p>	<p>City event bring together volunteers to cleanup city waterways – meeting at Wildlife Sanctuary</p>
<p>Church at East Ponce sidewalk Project (PH 2)</p> <p>Construction Schedule: Unknown – dependent on CSX permit. Anticipate June 2021</p>	<p>Upon receiving CSX permit, Phase 2 will commence with sidewalks on the CSX side of Church and EPDL including traffic islands on EPDL for pedestrian crossings (with 3 new rectangular rapid flashing beacons) – same as installed on Montreal Road</p>
