Notice of Property Tax Increase

The Governing Authority of the City of Clarkston has tentatively adopted a 2019 millage rate which will require an increase in the property taxes of 19.63 percent.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Clarkston will hold three (3) public hearings to discuss and take public comment on the proposed 2019 millage rate. The City Council has proposed and advertised the proposed rate of 15.89 mills, which is an increase of 2.607 mills over the rollback rate, of 13.283.

The first public hearing will be held on Tuesday, June 25, 2019 at 10:00am in the Clarkston Council Room, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021.

The second public hearing will be held on Tuesday, June 25, 2019 at 6:30pm in the Clarkston Council Room, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021.

A final Public Hearing will be held on July 2 at 7:00PM at the City Hall Council Rm, 3921 Church Street, Clarkston, GA 30021. The City Council will adopt the 2019 Millage rate at the July 2, 2019 meeting following the conclusion of the Public Hearing.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 15.89 mils, an increase of 2.607 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 13.283. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$ 100,000 is approximately \$ 104.28. The proposed increase on non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$ 525,000 is approximately \$ 547.47.
