BID #082924 is hereby revised as instructed throughout attached ADDENDUM No. 1.

This Addendum forms a part of the contract documents and modifies the original bid documents. The following items shall take precedence over the originally published bid documents for the above-named project and shall become a part of the contract documents.

- 1. Is there a requirement for core size? Can we assume that a 4-inch (nominal) diameter cores will be acceptable?
 - a. Yes
- 2. Does the City have any known information about which roads may contain soil-cement base or base course stone beneath the asphalt? Encountering these materials will slow progress in the field when compared to areas with only soil subgrade materials beneath the asphalt.
 - a. City has no records of the subgrade or sub-base materials.
- 3. Is only probing of the upper soils required? We can offer DCP testing at an additional fee. DCP testing will provide additional information regarding the underlying soil consistency and will help with determining appropriate repair recommendations.
 - a. Probing and observation of soil conditions will be adequate
- 4. Can a line item be added to the cost breakdown for the performance bond and payment bond? This requirement is not typical for professional services, but we would need to be compensated for the added cost associated with this requirement.
 - a. No bonding required at all
- 5. Will core locations be marked in the field by the owner (or an owner's representative) or will that be the responsibility of the bidder? Core locations need to be marked and GA811 utility location service needs to be contacted to clear marked areas for member utilities.
 - a. Core locations are marked. The awardee will be responsibility for contacting 811.

- 6. Is a bid bond a requirement to respond to this contract? As an engineering firm, this is typically not required as part of our services.
 - a. No bid bond required for these type of services.
- 7. Is it a requirement for a respondent to be a minority company or can we utilize subcontractors to satisfy the certified minority business question on the Vendor Questionnaire?
 - a. The questionnaire is related to the primary on this project. If your company utilizes a subcontractor, make sure the information is identified on the Subcontractor document and the preceding form is completed.
